**2. Review of March meeting minutes**

- Past minutes approved

**3. Patient Driven Payment Model discussion**

- Can't use unspecified codes. Must be primary diagnosis.
  - i.e.: Generalized weakness won't work. will need to use diagnosis causing generalized weakness
- Primary diagnosis must fall into one of 10 categories
- Primary diagnosis does not need to be in subsequent notes, must be in the first note
- Most relevant for short-term or TCU patient
- Veronica checking to see if PDPM and PDGM are the same coding theory. PDGM is for home care and starts 1 – 2020.
- Clinicians may be asked to add codes to increase reimbursement.
  - i.e.: Morbid obesity, COPD with shortness of breath when lying flat, malnutrition.
- Cannot use likely, suspected, questionable, etc.
- Clinicians may be asked to adjust codes prior to October 1, 2019 to better reflect the current state of patients before this goes into effect.
- Care will not change, but how coding is done will need to change to reflect the care patients are receiving. See page 4, slide 2 of Veronica's hand out
